The following submissions have been accepted and included on a Letter of Intent to the College of Arms from Atlantia dated 25 November, 2004:

Antonio di Capizzi. New name.

Atlantia, Kingdom of. Sergeants of Saint Aidan. New change of name from Company of Saint Aidan.

Bessenyei Rossa. New badge. (Fieldless) On a crescent sable a lotus blossom in profile argent.

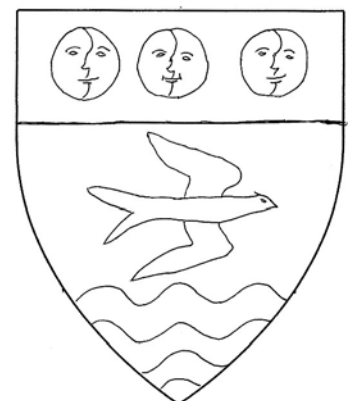
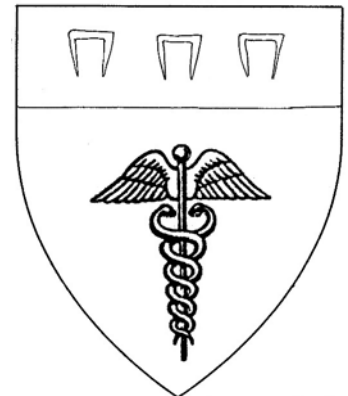
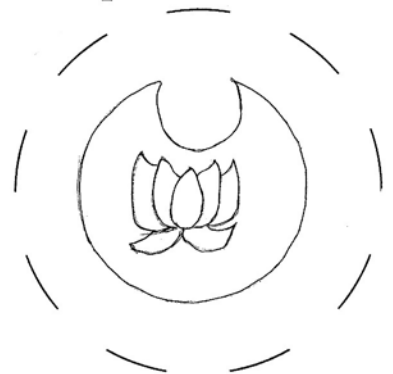
Emma Barfoot. New name.

Etain of Sutherland. New name (see RETURNS for device)

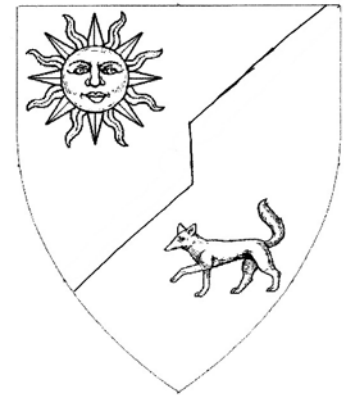
Gertrude zu dem Walde. New name (see RETURNS for device)

James Sutherland of Inverness. New device. Argent, a caduceus sable and on a chief azure three staples argent. This device was pended from October, 2004, for redrawing. The illustration shows the redrawn device.

Katherine O'Carroll. New device. Azure, a dove volant to sinister and in base two bars wavy, on a chief argent three moons in their plenitude azure. This device was pended from October, 2004, for redrawing. The illustration shows the redrawn device.



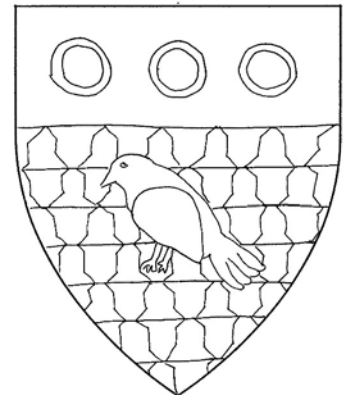
Lidia de Ragusa. New device. Per bend sinister bevilled azure and argent, a sun in splendor Or and a fox passant azure. This device was pended from October, 2004, for redrawing. The illustration shows the redrawn device.



Lora Moore. New name and device. Per bend sinister sable and azure, in bend two lightning bolts bendwise sinister argent.

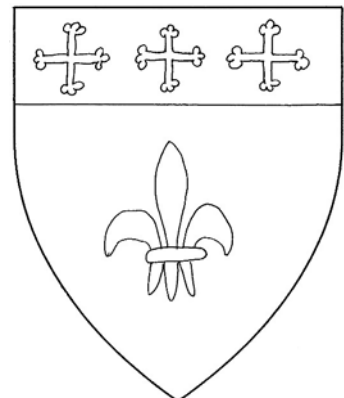


Magdalena Ilianova. New device. Vair, a magpie sable and on a chief gules three annulets Or. This device was pended from October, 2004, for redrawing. The illustration shows the redrawn device.



Marlein Magdalena Weber von Rothenburg. New name (see RETURNS for device). This was originally submitted as Marlein Magdalena Weber von Rothenburg ob der Tauber, but we dropped the river modifier as it does not seem to appear in medieval bynames which use this place name.

Melisent la Ruse. New device. Vert, a fleur-de-lys Or and on a chief argent, three crosses bottony sable. Her name was on the October Letter of Intent from Atlantia. This device was pended from October, 2004.



Robert Pine. House Beehive. New household name and badge.
(Fieldless) A beehive within and conjoined to an annulet argent.

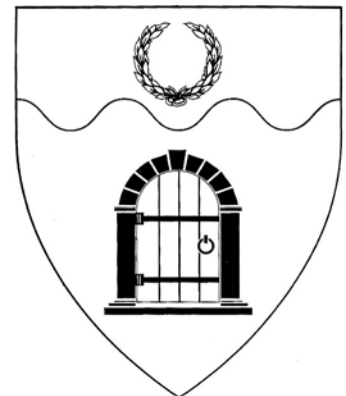


Raphael de la Rosa. New name and badge. (Fieldless) A scythe bendwise and overall a skull argent.



Sudentorre, Canton of. Resubmission of device. Argent, a wooden door proper within and conjoined to a stepped arch sable masoned argent, on a chief wavy azure a laurel wreath argent.

Vittorio Mezzadri. New name.

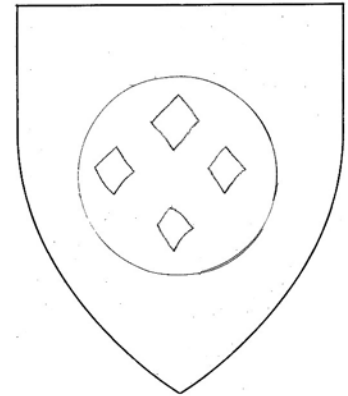


RETURNS:

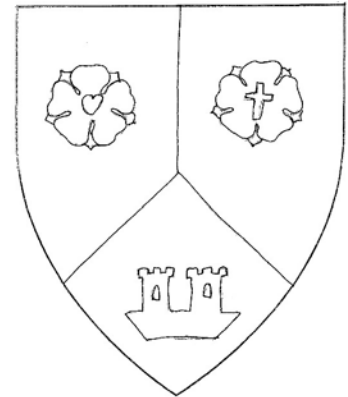
Etain of Sutherland. New device. Gules, on a bezant a raven sable. This unfortunately conflicts with Leofua of Thornridge (“Gules, on a bezant, a leopard leaping bendwise sinister, head to base, sable.”) By precedent, only one difference can be derived from tertiary charges, no matter how many changes are made.



Gertrude zu dem Walde. New device. Sable, on a bezant four lozenges in cross gules. Unfortunately, this conflicts with Gwynnaeth Math o Ddylluan (“Sable, a bezant charged with a raven on a branch bendwise all sable.”). By precedent, only one difference can be derived from tertiary charges, no matter how many changes are made.

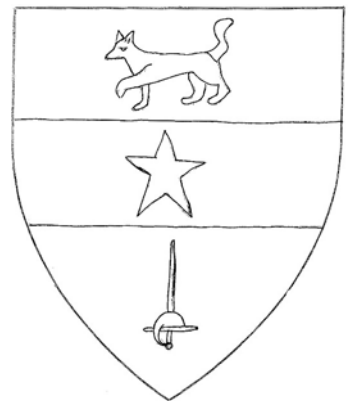


Marlein Magdalena Weber von Rothenburg. New device. Per pall inverted sable, argent and gules, two roses countercharged argent and gules, barbed vert, the dexter charged with a heart sable, the sinister with a cross argent, and a castle Or. There was a general consensus that the overall design of the device was too complex, with four different types of charges and five tinctures. Moreover, the complexity was exaggerated by the use of two different charges on the otherwise symmetrical roses. Also, some commenters felt the depiction of the castle in base was insufficiently identifiable.



PENDS:

Uilleam MacWylie. New name and device. Argent, on a fess azure between a fox passant and a rapier palewise gules, a mullet argent. Since the submitted name did not match the documentation, but was very close to documented forms and the submitter allowed changes, we have pended this to allow the submitter to indicate which option he prefers. Though the device seemed acceptable, it could not be forwarded to Laurel for lack of a registerable Society name.
