

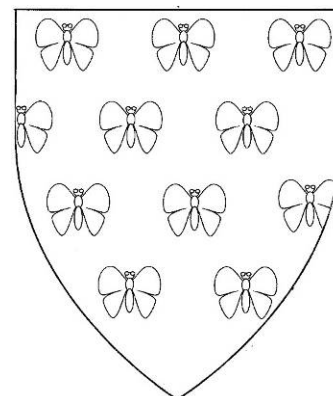

The following items were REGISTERED by the Laurel Office:

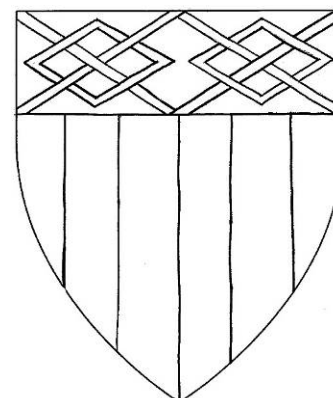

Since the submitter had requested authenticity for fourteenth century Germany, the Laurel staff dropped the locative vom Schwarzwald that had been in the submitted name because they felt that double bynames that combine an occupational name and a locative do not appear commonly in Germany until the fifteenth century.



Amber Roriksdatter. Alternate persona name for Barbara of Bonei.

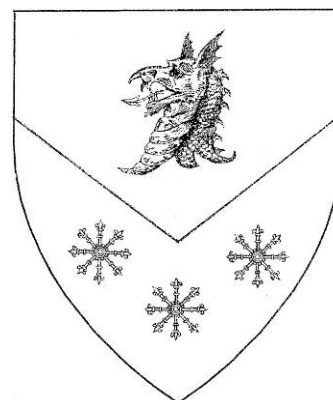
Deborah Morrison. Name.

Ellen of York. Device. Paly azure and argent, on a chief argent two frets azure.

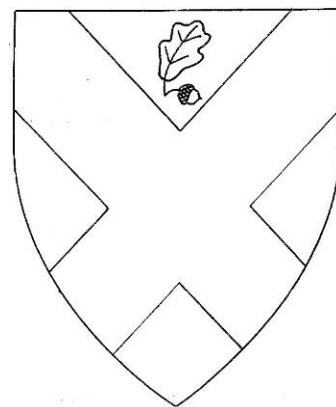


Elsbeth Magdalena Drachenfels. Name and device. Per chevron inverted sable and azure, a dragon's head erased and three escarbuncles two and one argent.

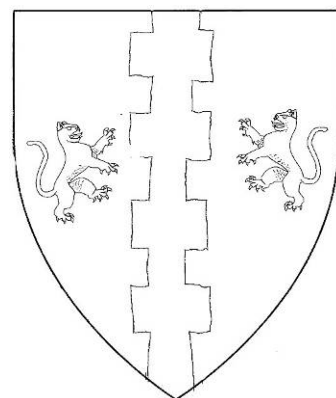
Fridha av Bergen. Name.

Philippa Tillinghast. Name and device. Argent, a pale brethesed gules between a cat rampant to sinister azure and a cat rampant vert.



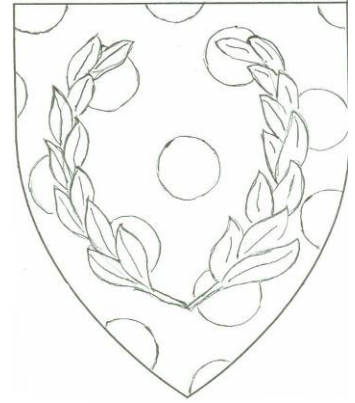
Randolf Garard. Badge. Sable, a wolf statant argent and a bordure embattled Or.
