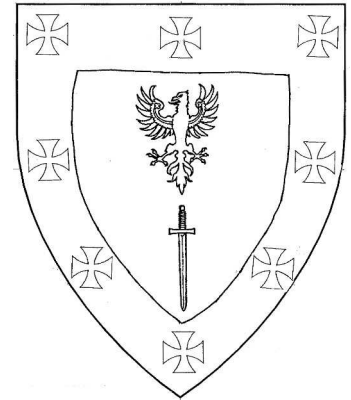
The Laurel Office has notified us of the results of its considerations at the meetings in August, 2007.

These results were conveyed in a communication received in Atlantia on 10 December, 2007.

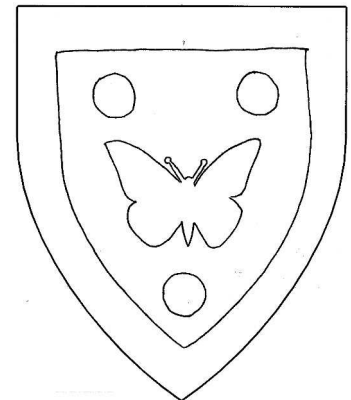
## ACCEPTANCES

The following items were REGISTERED by the Laurel Office:

**Agostino da Palermo.** Name and device. Azure, in pale an eagle displayed and a sword inverted Or within a bordure Or crusilly formy gules.



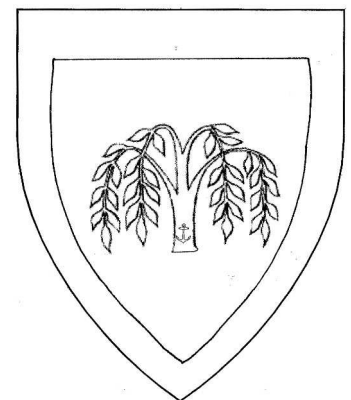
**Bella Farinelli.** Device. Sable, a butterfly between three roundels, all within a bordure argent.



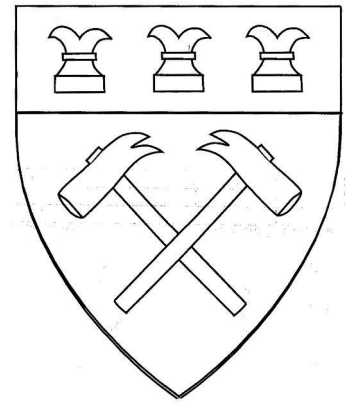
**Bella Trentavasi.** Name (see RETURNS for device).

**Bertran de Saint-Jean.** Name.

**Erik Olafssen.** Device. Argent, a weeping willow tree couped sable charged on the trunk with an anchor argent, all within a bordure gules. The Laurel staff asked that the tree and trunk be drawn so as to allow more space for the anchor to be larger and more visible.



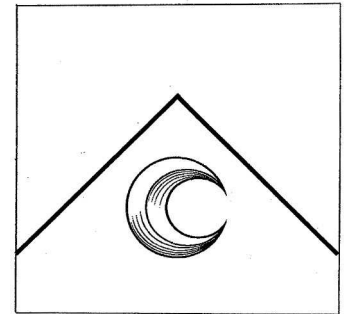
**Francesca Lorenza Caterina Marino.** Device. Azure, in saltire two hammers, on a chief argent three chess rooks sable..



**Gisela Garces de Navarra.** Name.

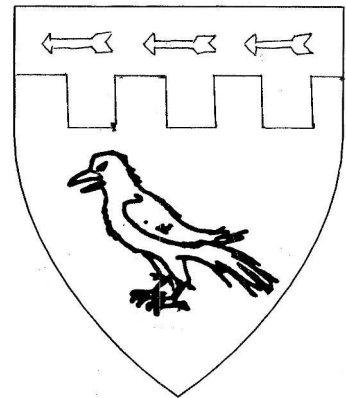
**Gwenllian ferch Maredudd.** Blanket permission to conflict. Gwenllian ferch Maredudd has granted blanket permission for any future submitter to register armory that is at least one countable step different from her registered armory of "Argent, a bend cotised sable between six crescents azure."

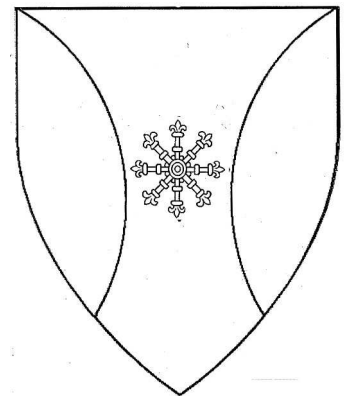


**Hawkwood, Barony of.** Badge for the Order of the Golden Moon. Per chevron argent and azure, in base a decrescent Or.

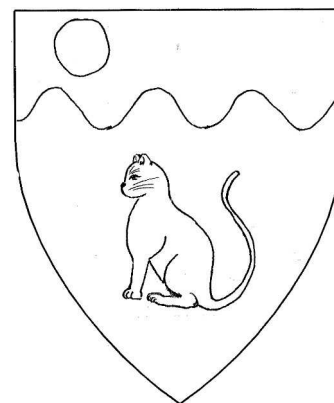
**John of Caer Gelynniog.** Device. Sable, a raven and on a chief embattled argent, three arrows fesswise reversed gules.



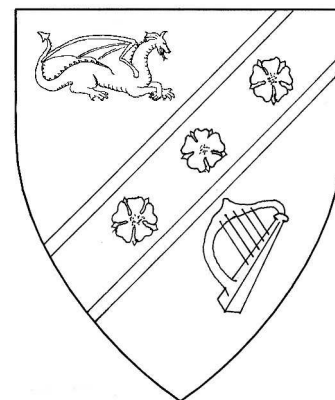
**Katel of Ipswich.** Device. Argent, an escarbuncle between flaunches sable.



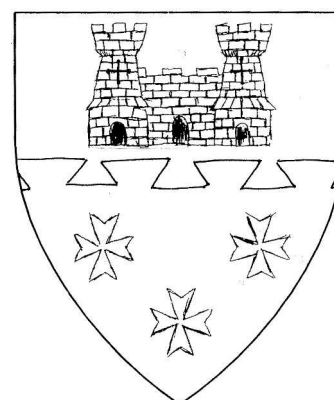
**Líadan ingen Fháeláin.** Device. Or, a domestic cat sejant sable and on a chief wavy vert in canton a bezant.



**Mærwynn de More.** Device. Vert, on a bend sinister purpure fimbriated between a dragon couchant contourny and a harp, three roses argent.



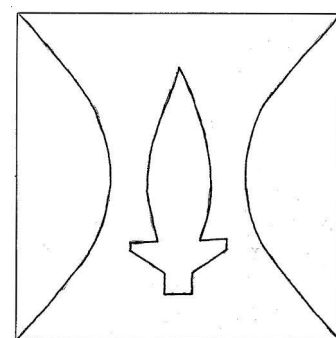
**Morgant Capellanus.** Device. Per fess dovetailed gules and sable, in pale a castle and three Maltese crosses argent.

**Sean Dalamara.** Badge. Argent, a boarspear head sable between flaunches azure.

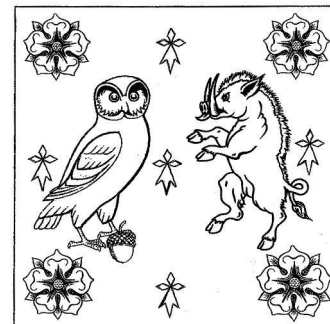

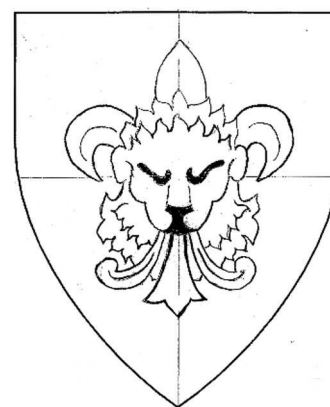
## RETURNS

The following items were RETURNED by the Laurel Office:

**Adeliza of Bristol.** Badge. Sable, three ermine spots in pale Or between an owl contourny maintaining an acorn argent and a boar rampant, between two ermine spots in fess Or, all between two roses in bend argent and two roses in bend sinister Or. The Laurel staff returned the badge because they felt it was not really blazonable as drawn was not period style and was too complex, saying “This is borderline when it comes to complexity and, in association with the non-period style of the device and the trouble in blazoning it, is grounds for return.”



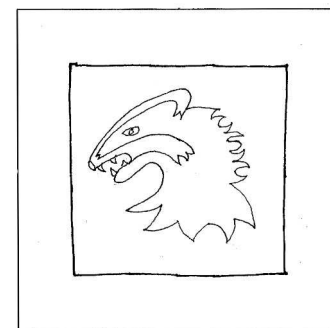
**Bella Trentavasi.** Device. Quarterly sable and argent, a lion's head Or jessant-de-lys gules. Unfortunately, the Laurel staff returned this device for conflict with the badge for Cathyn Fitzgerald (“(Fieldless) A lion's head Or jessant-de-lys gules.”). That badge was registered at the Laurel meetings of January, 2007, but the letter on which the registration was contained did not arrive in Atlantia until 1 May, three days after Bella's armory was submitted to the College of Arms, and did not reach the online Armorial and Ordinary until some time later.



**Hawkwood, Barony of.** Badge for the Award of the Silver Wings of Hawkwood. Azure, a winged lantern argent. Unfortunately, the Laurel staff returned this badge for conflict with Angus MacNokard (“Azure, a winged tankard argent.”), ruling that there was only a single point of difference for the visual differences between a winged lantern and a winged tankard.



**Kristin Ailbe Anmclaid.** Badge. Or, a badger's head erased sable within a bordure gules. Unfortunately, the Laurel staff returned this badge for conflict with Juan Santiago (“Or, a natural panther's head coupé sable within a bordure gules.”) because they ruled that there was only a single difference in type of charge between the heads, specifically ruling that these two heads were not substantially different in type.



**Matthew of Battle.** Badge. Gules, a mullet pierced argent within a bordure Or. This was returned because the submission was withdrawn by the submitter.
