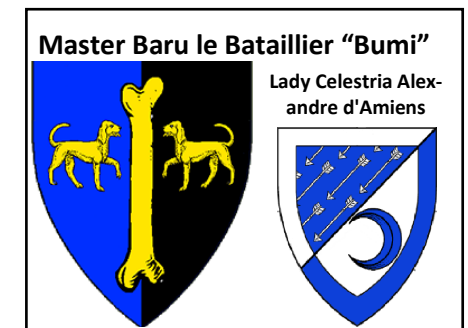
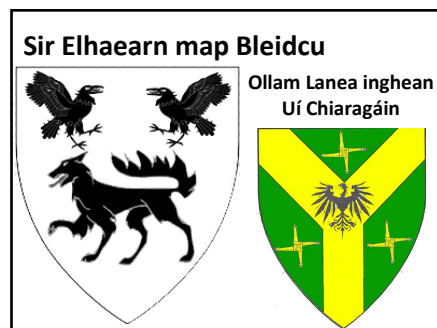
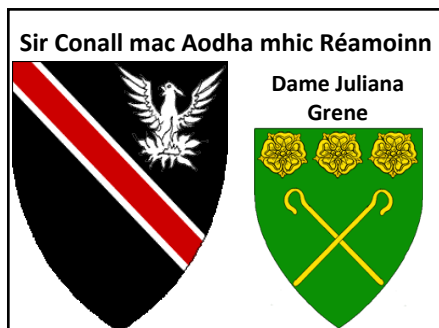
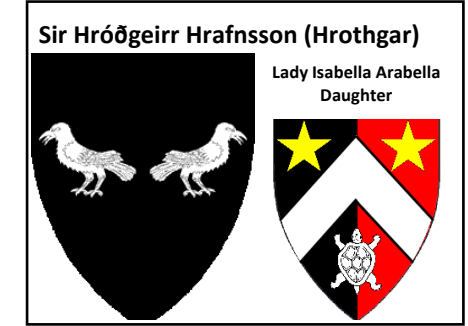
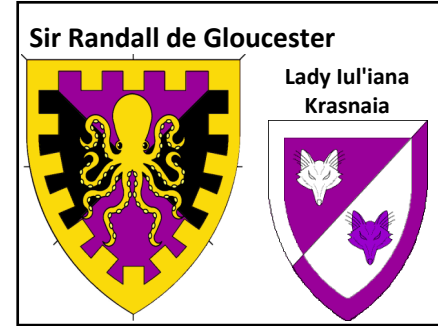
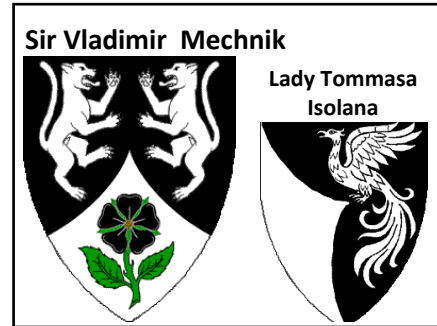
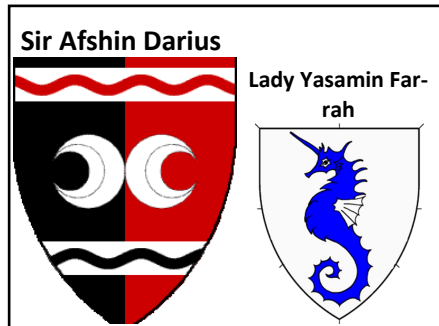
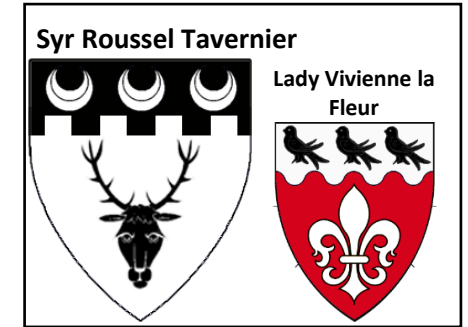
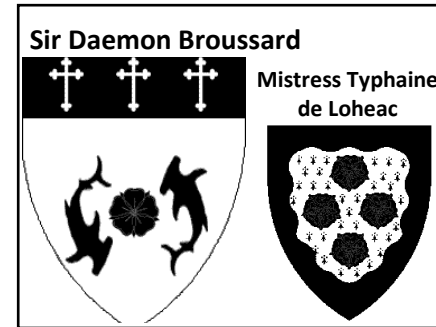
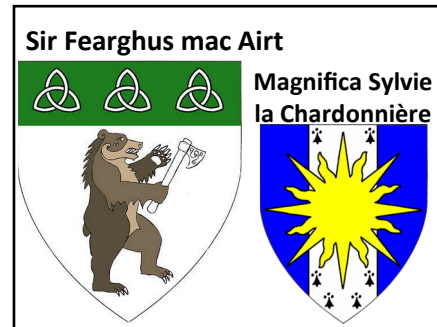
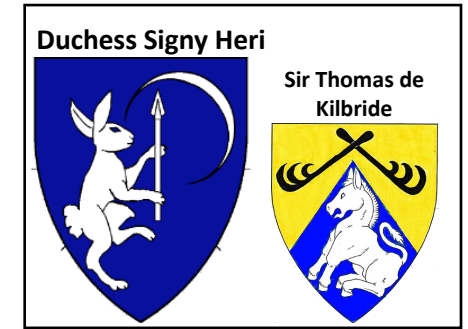
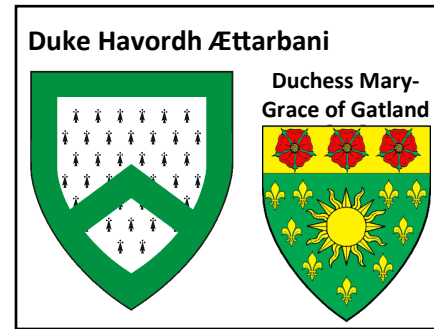


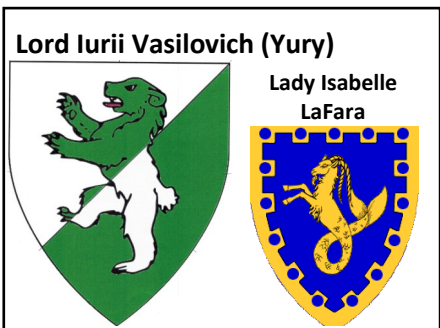
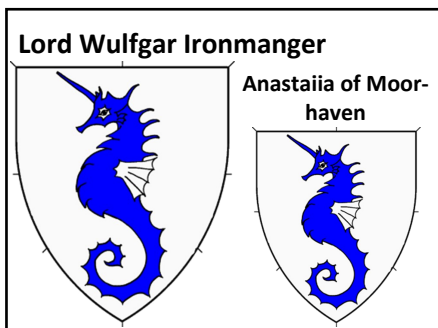
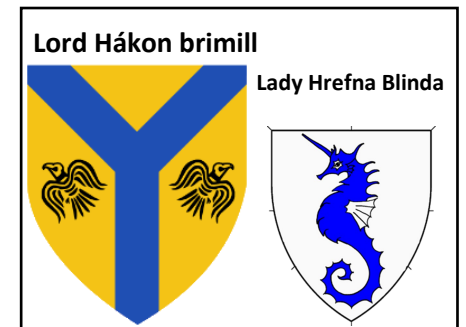
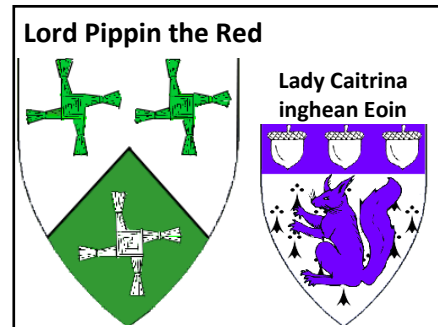
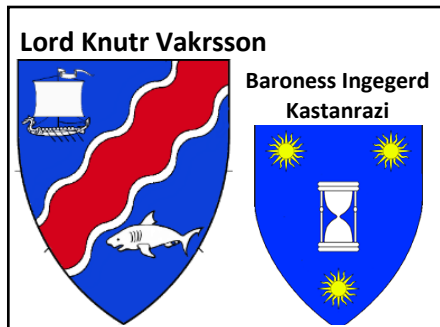
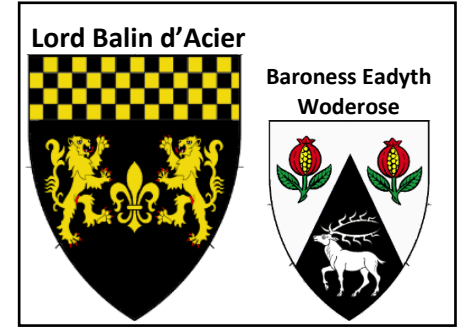
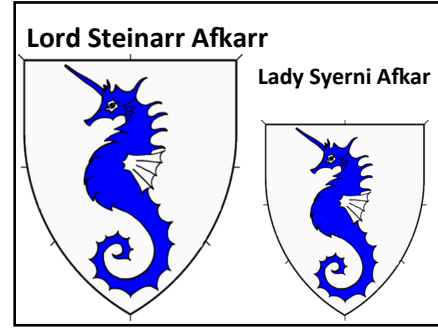
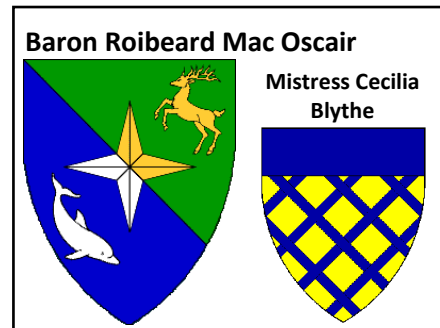
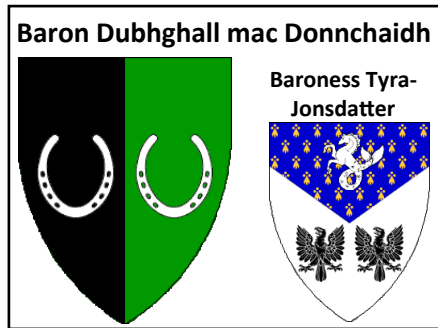
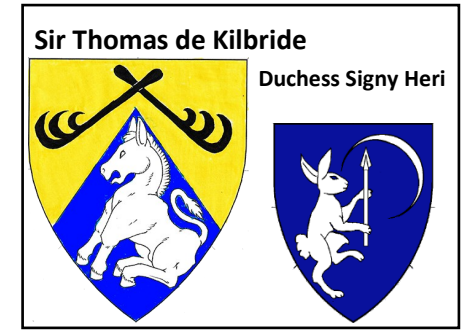
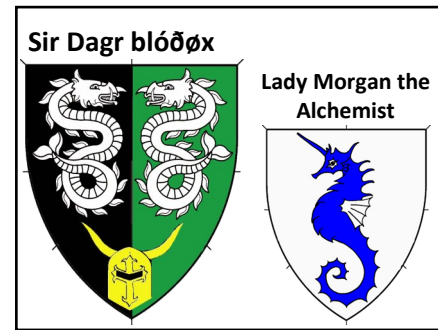
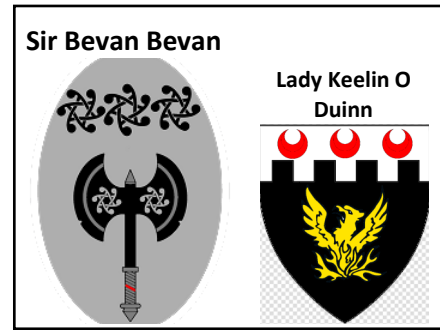
## Atlantian Crown Tournament Heraldic Guide Fall 2022
